

Annual Fund

Each year, Rice depends on the generosity of all the members of the Rice Family to make contributions on behalf of the Annual Fund.

These unrestricted funds are used to bridge the gap between the cost of tuition and the actual cost of educating a student. The “gap” is approximately \$5,000 per student.

By contributing to the schools’ operating budget, the Annual Fund is used primarily to augment the schools’ program offerings, faculty compensation, technology advancement, financial aid programs and maintenance to the physical plant.

Securities: Gifts of appreciated securities may offer significant tax advantages to the donor and are very simple to arrange. Credit is given and a tax deduction is allowable for the value of the mean of the high and low prices of the stock on the day of the transfer of the securities to Rice High School.
